SUBJECT: Proposal to Align Board Committee Work Plans with Calendar Year in Coordination with the State Bar's Strategic Planning Cycle – Request for Approval

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This agenda item proposes to align the development and review of Work Plans for the Board Committees – Regulation and Discipline, Programs, Finance and Planning, and Audit – with the calendar year, in coordination with the Board of Trustees' Strategic Planning cycle. Developing and reviewing Committee Work Plans on a cycle that is coordinated with Strategic Planning will facilitate the alignment of Committee Work Plans with the strategic goals and objectives of the Bar.

BACKGROUND

The 2017 Governance in the Public Interest Task Force unanimously agreed that the State Bar's committee process should function more vigorously, allowing the Board to focus on policy issues while maintaining its oversight role with regard to the discipline system, the admissions function and State Bar finances.

At its January 2018 meeting the Board approved amendments to the Board Book requiring the Regulation and Discipline, Programs, Finance and Planning, and Audit Committees to propose and follow work plans. At the same meeting, the Board Executive Committee approved work plans developed by those committees in the fall of 2017. A copy of the Committee Work Plans is attached to this item.

DISCUSSION

Currently, the committees are required to submit their annual work plans based upon the Board's September-based cycle of appointments. Committee chairs are appointed during the September meeting by the new Board chair. In 2017, Committee staff worked with their respective committees in the fall to develop and adopt work plans. The timing of this process, however, prevented the coordination of the Committee Work Plans with the Board's Strategic Planning process.

To encourage more thoughtful and productive work plans and ensure their alignment with the strategic work of the Bar, new Committee chairs should be given the fall to familiarize themselves on their Committees' respective work plans and then, with the support of Bar staff, to develop a new work plan that is informed by the work of the previous year and that aligns with the Bar's Strategic Plan.

Bar staff will work to develop a new process for aligning the review and updating of the Strategic Plan with the review and updating of Board Committee work plans. The sequence of meetings should involve holding the Board's January strategic planning meeting first followed by the convening of Board Committee meetings.
