

**RESOLUTION TO CHANGE EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS
TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the governing body of THE STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA has the authority to implement Government Code Section 20691;

WHEREAS, the governing body of THE STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA has had a written labor policy or agreement which has since 2004 specifically provided for the normal member contributions to be paid by the employer;

WHEREAS, the governing body of THE STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA is ending the policy or agreement providing that member contributions be paid by the employer and instead will require member contributions to be paid by the employee commencing with the first pay period in 2014;

WHEREAS, the governing body of THE STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA will continue the written policy of paying member contributions for statutorily defined State Bar Court Judges;

WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement Section 20691 is the adoption by the governing body of THE STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA of a Resolution to govern Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC);

WHEREAS, the governing body of THE STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA has identified the following conditions for the purpose of ending its previous election to pay EPMC;

- This shall apply to all employees classified as Miscellaneous Members except statutorily defined State Bar Court Judges;
- The employer shall pay 0% (Zero Percent) of the normal member contributions as EPMC for all Miscellaneous Members;
- The employer shall continue to pay 7% (Seven Percent) of the normal member contributions as EPMC for statutorily defined State Bar Court Judges;
- The effective date of this Resolution shall be January 1, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of THE STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA elects to end paying EPMC, as set forth above.
