Proposed Amendment to State Bar Rule 3.662(A) to Extend Trust Fund Commission Term Limits to Two Consecutive Three-year Terms

Rule 3.662(A)

The Board of Trustees appoints fourteen voting members, ten of whom must be members of the State Bar and four of whom must be public members who have never been admitted to the practice of law in any United States jurisdiction. Each member serves at the pleasure of the Board for a term of three years that begins and ends at the State Bar annual meeting. Upon completion of an initial term, the Board may reappoint a member for a second three-year term. The Board may extend an initial or second term by one or two years to allow a member to serve as chair or vice-chair.
