SUBJECT: Appointment of Members: Governance in the Public Interest Task Force

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

[Business and Professions Code section 6001.2](#) requires the State Bar to create a Governance in the Public Interest Task Force (GIPITF) comprised of seven members, including:

- Three attorney members of the board of trustees:
 - one of whom shall be a Supreme Court appointee who is selected by the Supreme Court appointees; and
 - one of whom shall be the member appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; and
 - one of whom shall be the member appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly.
- Three public members of the board of trustees:
 - one of whom shall be the member appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules;
 - one of whom shall be the member appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly; and
 - one of whom shall be selected by the Governor's appointees.
- The Board chair, who shall preside over all meetings.

Beginning on May 15, 2014, and every three years thereafter, the GIPITF is required to prepare and submit a report to the Supreme Court, the governor, and the Assembly and Senate Committees on Judiciary that includes its recommendations for enhancing the protection of the public and ensuring that protection of the public is the highest priority in the licensing, regulation, and discipline of attorneys.
