6. Complete the production of Admissions' training videos on the following topic: "preparing to take the Bar Exam;" for both applicants and proctor training.

7. Review of examination fees; specifically, the cost differential for attorney applicants.

November 2022 (Pending, Board of Trustees)

8. Review possible revisions to Rule 4.17 to be sworn-in no later than five (5) years after passing the California Bar Examination.
