

Rejected Fees Policy

First-Year Law Students' Examination and California Bar Examination applications that do not have a successfully settled payment will be considered incomplete. An unsuccessful payment or rejected payment includes, but is not limited to, returned checks, declined ACH payments, or credit card chargebacks requested by the credit card holder.

All rejected payments will be assessed an insufficient payment administrative fee in the amount of \$20.

If acceptable payment is not received within 14 days from notification of an insufficient payment by the State Bar of California, the application will be deemed abandoned.

If the application final filing deadline has not passed, an applicant may submit a new application. The application must be accompanied by the appropriate payment, including any applicable late fees in effect at that time.
