Bar Exam Cost Reduction Models

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Why the Need?

Current proposal for increases to admissions fees still result in expenditures exceeding projected revenue by **\$1,054,172**

Unless fees are further increased, cost reductions are required

Key Opportunities for Changes to Exam Administration Discussed



Consolidate administration into fewer sites



Options to remotely administer essays and performance test



Use of State Bar offices or similar facilities for testing accommodations applicants

Themes from Public Comment

1. Significant financial burden
2. Additional stress, anxiety, and chaos
3. Disproportionate burden on people of color, with disabilities, and/or lower socioeconomic status
4. Impact on those with childcare or adult care obligations
5. Disparate impact on those from other than LA or SF
6. Disadvantages San Diego – large city, 3 law schools



Action and Next Steps

- Board is asked today to approve staff recommended sites for February 2024.
- Staff will come back with a proposal for July likely to include remote option to fully address structural deficit.
